Study areas of particular interest:

1. International Management (in English)

Courses look at the international aspects of marketing, finance, logistics, trade, human resources, economics and business law as well as intercultural communication & competence, international project management and country analysis.

2. Logistics (in German)

A degree programme focusing on different aspects of logistics, e.g. transport, storage & handling systems, supply chain management, transport & packaging technology, logistics management.

3. Aeronautical Engineering (in German)

The degree programme offers on two majors:

1. Design & Lightweight Structures: Aerodynamics, Aircraft Design, Aircraft Propulsion, Composite Materials
2. Cabin & Cabin Systems: Cabin Architecture, Cabin Systems, Ergonomics & Design, Aircraft System Design

4. Automotive Engineering (in German)

The degree programme offers on three majors:

1. Body Design
2. Design of motors & transmissions
3. Commercial & Special Vehicles

5. Biomedical Engineering (in German)

A cooperation with a hospital in radiology (MRI projects), a fully equipped ICU and well-equipped labs in the university allow a practice-oriented degree programme with excellent research options. Biomechanics, ultrasound & medical software are important study focuses.

Hamburg is the third largest centre for civil aviation worldwide. The aviation industry is the industrial motor in Hamburg with aircraft manufacture and development (AIRBUS), maintenance (Lufthansa Technik) and the many small and middle-sized companies manufacturing parts for this industry.
