Prerequisites in detail

- Academic aptitude, demonstrated by the quality of doctoral work
- Demonstrated teaching ability
- Record of achievement during at least five years of professional activity, including at least three years outside of academia (this period can be reduced in exceptional cases, e.g. through a combination of outstanding scientific research and international experience)
- Appointees without fluency in German are expected to acquire sufficient proficiency for their teaching and administrative responsibilities within a reasonable time frame, unless otherwise specified

The Seven German Universities of Applied Sciences (UAS7) offer

- A dynamic and supportive academic community with high teaching and research standards
- Academic freedom
- A supportive environment for research in cooperation with business and industry
- Strong networks of international academic collaboration
- Teaching in small groups
- Teaching in English or German, depending on department needs
- Support systems to facilitate the start in the new position
- Flexible working hours and support for work-life balance, including family-friendly policies

Working conditions for professors at UAS7 universities

- Tenure (usually after a 12-month evaluation period)
- Salaries set by German university legislation, with some scope for negotiation to reward merit and performance
- Responsibilities include teaching, research, and contributions to faculty-led university administration
- Up to 18 hours of teaching per week during the term (possible reductions for funded research and/or administrative responsibilities)
- Possibility to continue private professional practice on a limited basis
